They had a chance to visit a grandiose circular building where every month four days a week 732 Members of European Parliament have sessions. The part of this field trip was a lecture on principles of making decisions and the way of negotiations. The students also learned about the authorization of affairs of European significance. Mr. Duchoň answered all their questions and he enabled them the access to the Parliament gallery where they witnessed how obligatory European directives are passed. In the building of European Court for human rights they could admire not only the beauty of architecture but also professionals working here. The students and the teachers are really obliged to Mr. Duchoň and his team for making this outstanding experience possible for them.
