JA STUDENTS AND TEACHERS IN LEGISLATORS ROLES

Selected students and teachers from Czech and Moravian secondary schools and colleges had a unique opportunity to participate in an event called Parliamentary Simulation, which was held on the 18th of September right in the **Chamber of Deputies** premises in the co-operation with the **CEVRO Institute** and under the auspices of the **Constitutional & Legal Committee**. The Parliamentary Simulation introduced the process of a law creation to the participants. Students and teachers got involved in this process directly, being divided into groups, which represented individual political parties. During the day, all three Chamber of Deputies plenum readings and clubs meetings were simulated. Professional consultants supervised the work of the participants and explained, commented and evaluated individual steps during the tasks. The event administrators chose a suitable topic for the simulation, which had an economic background and was close to the students at the same time. The topic was University Training Fees. The participants tested their communication and public speaking skills and team work abilities. The program was finished by an excursion through the premises of the Chamber of Deputies.
